## **Earworm activity:**

This is the ideal finger game and a good intro to Peek-a-boo! Entwine your fingers in front of baby's face, thumbs facing upwards. As the first sparrow flies away, "hide" the finger behind the other fingers. Do the same with the second finger. When you come to "one little brick wall" move your hands in front of your face and then part your fingers on Peek-a-boo!

You can also do a tummy time exercise on this song. Let baby lie on her stomach and have 2 soft toys representing the birds. Let the birds fly in different directions and try to see whether baby eyes track the movement. On peek-a-boo let the birds fly back and land in front of baby.

Let the children listen if they can hear the "tweets" in the music.

Classical music to listen to:
